Type of Gift

There are four types of gift you can make in your Will:

- **A Pecuniary Gift** – this allows you to give a specific amount of money.
- **A Residuary Gift** – this can be a bequest of the whole, or portion of your estate remaining after all other legacies, Inheritance Tax, debts and expenses have been paid.
- **A Specific Gift** – a gift of a specific personal possession such as property, antiques, works of art and stocks and shares (see Inland Revenue leaflet IR178 for information on giving stocks and shares).
- **A Reversionary Gift** – this type of gift allows you to leave assets to us whilst giving a named person the benefit of them during his or her lifetime.

Your Gift & Tax

The Nature in Art Trust is a registered charity and gifts to us are exempt from Inheritance Tax and Capital Gains Tax. Therefore a gift to us will reduce the amount of tax payable out of your estate.

Professional Advice

We would suggest that you may want to seek professional advice to ensure that your intentions are clearly stated and that you are fully aware of tax issues.
