In light of the ongoing situation the UK faces with COVID-19 and in line with medical advice, Nature in Art will be closed with immediate effect until further notice.

This has been a very difficult decision to make but the health and wellbeing of our visitors, volunteers, artists, staff and wider community is our priority. Therefore, we believe that temporarily closure is the best decision based on current advice.

We realise that our decision will have consequences for many of the artists, organisations and collaborators we work with along with our many members and visitors, who support us day to day and may have purchased tickets for forthcoming events. Please be assured we will work hard to try to limit the impact and will endeavour to rearrange as much as possible to a later date.
