

## **COVID-19 MEASURES PUT IN PLACE FOR THE SAFETY OF VISITORS AND STAFF AT NATURE IN ART**

**In addition to introducing our booking system and always operating with limited numbers in the building at any one time, we have undertaken rigorous risk assessments and now have a variety of measures and controls in place. These include:**

- separate entrances for the museum and coffee shop
- signage inside and outside the building
- a welcomer on the door to take your temperature and explain the arrangements
- automatic hand sanitisers outside both entrance doors with additional units throughout the building
- traffic light control for the main stairs
- number limits and one-way viewing in each gallery
- social distancing respected throughout the buildings
- staff and volunteers wearing visors
- visitors must wear a mask
- protective screen on the shop and coffee shop counters
- payment by card or contactless requested (cash payments only as a last resort)
- intensive cleaning regime
- use of commercial airborne pathogen neutralizers (a technology used in hospital operating theatres)
