The health and wellbeing of our visitors, volunteers, artists, staff and wider community has been our priority and will remain so going forward.

Our closure had consequences for our many supporters and visitors as well as the artists, organisations and collaborators with whom we work. We have worked hard to try and limit the impact, but sadly have had to cancel or postpone most of our special programmes and events and our plans for 2021 are uncertain. We will endeavour to rearrange as much as possible to a later date.
